

Dear colleagues,

I am pleased to announce the availability of the 2025-2026 Provost Faculty Research Fund and to report that the faculty who have been supported by the Fund have engaged in substantive, innovative and consequential research.

Please see below the eligible activities for the 2025-2026 academic year.

#### Eligibility

- Clinical, tenure-track and tenured faculty from all Yeshiva University's schools and colleges.
- Faculty who do not have the following: contractual start-up funds or research dollars, grant or school-funded summer salary, and/or awardees of individual YU school research funds (e.g. Cardozo Law School).
- Faculty may apply for either an individual or collaborative grant.

#### Ineligible Faculty

- Faculty who have contractual start-up funds, research dollars, grant funds or school-funded summer salary.
- 2024-2025 Faculty Research Fund awardees

#### Application Details:

- Individual grants up to \$7,500
- Collaborative grants up to \$10,000 with eligible colleagues **within** one's school/college **and/or other** YU's schools.

Applications must be submitted by Tuesday, July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025.

Faculty may apply for travel to conferences for up to \$2000 **only** after expending funds provided by one's school or college. Applications will be accepted for as long funds are available.

#### Application Process:

A Deans' Committee will once again review all applications submitted by Tuesday, July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025.

**Examples of Permissible Research Award Expenses:**

- General research related expenses
- Publication costs
- Data sets
- Books, reprints, and one-time subscriptions to academic journals
- Stipends for student researchers
- Translation services
- Computer software
- Mobile app design
- Transcription services
- Domestic and international travel (as it relates to research)
- Purchase of photographs or other visual materials.

**Non-allowable Research Award Expenses:**

- Computers, computer hardware, or ipads
- Salary as it relates to the Provost Faculty Research Fund
- Honoraria or guest lecturers
- Food or alcohol
- Impermissible University expenses (please see Use of Award Guidelines).

Awarded funds will expire on June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2026.
